Save the date! Hold Saturday, October 21st open for our second annual spaghetti dinner and dance. More details to follow.

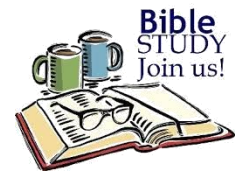
